Another year has come and the first month of it is history. Time marches on and so does the ministry that we are blessed to be involved with. It is never boring at the Sycamores Chapel!

Sally and I have been heavily involved with the next stages of the Friendship Kitchen ministry which feeds the homeless and elderly here in Eastern Oklahoma. In January we have averaged 105 clients each Saturday of the month. Twelve local churches help us with this outreach and I am happy to report that we have seen people come to know the Lord and begin their walk in the newness of life with the Lord. As you can imagine, it is not usually an easy transition from the outhouse to the penthouse, but God is in control. We are in the process of beginning a new outreach with this population of people in another area of Oklahoma. We are searching for our church partners and searching for the place where it will be housed. Please pray with us as we pursue this first step of ministry outreach to a new community.



The International portion of the CRMI ministry is growing and doing well. Landa Carnes will be home from Nicaragua during February and March. She will be speaking to our local CRMI family the first week-end in March and we are excited to hear about how God has been using her as she touches young girls who have been rescued from the sex trades. Please continue to pray for Landa.

In the West Indies, Terry and Marta Lansdale are planting additional churches on other Islands. It is an exciting time for the ministry as they continue to win the lost and disciple new believers. One of the things we have been able to help with is the implementation of disaster relief plans on St. John. We are working closely with St. John Rescue to provide them with new CPR tools so that the population can be trained to help others. New CPR practice dummies and AED's are being supplied as CRMI partners with international relief agencies to assist those who can't help themselves.

Thank you for praying for us and for your support. Without that we could not serve in the way that we are currently doing. Please pray for several needs of the ministry here locally.

- (1) Please pray for a suitable tiller to begin our soil preparation for the community garden we put out each year. This 4000 square foot garden feeds many of those who are in deep need. Our tiller from last year finally gave up the ghost. God has a new one for us. Please help us pray it in.
- (2) Please pray for our international ministry opportunities as they are beginning to bear fruit in areas of the world that need it desperately. Our CRMI International Chaplain are wonderful men and women of faith. Pray for them to excel in coming months.
